4. Products covered (HS or CCCN where applicable, otherwise national tariff heading. ICS numbers may be provided in addition, where applicable): Generator sets (up to 19 kilowatt) run on petrol and kerosene
5. Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document: Emission standards for new generator sets (upto 19 kilowatt) run on petrol and kerosene; GSR 682(E) , dated 5 October 1999 (6 pages, in Hindi and English).
6. Description of content: The Ministry of Environment & Forests, Govt. of India, notification viz. GSR 682(E) , dated 5 October 1999, at SI. No. 88, prescribes that all new generator sets (upto 19 kilowatt) run on petrol/kerosene shall meet the prescribed emission limits.
7. Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable: Environment safety, pollution control. Rationale: Due to acute power shortage in the country, the generator sets have become the major source of energy in India. As a result of the use of generator sets in large numbers, pressure on the environment have become paramount. To control air pollution, the regulations have been put in place.

9.	Proposed date of adoption: Already in force in the following phase Proposed date of entry into force: a) 1 June 2000 – Phase I emission limits b) 1 June 2001 – Phase II emission limits
