Explanatory Notes

1. Alphabetical divisions indicated against individual sectors or sub-sectors and numbers in brackets are references to the Services Sectoral Classification List (GATT Document MTN.GNS/W/120, dated July 10, 1991).
2. The reference to “CPC” against specific sectors or sub-sectors is a reference to the Provisional Central Product Classification (Statistical Papers, Series M, No. 77, Department of International Economic and Social Affairs, Statistical Office of the United Nations, New York, 1991). The reference to “CPC ver. 1.0” is a reference to the Central Product Classification (Statistical Papers, Series M, No. 77, Ver. 1.0, Department of International Economic and Social Affairs, Statistical Office of the United Nations, New York, 1998). The Schedule does not include measures relating to qualification requirements and procedures, technical standards, authorisation requirements and licensing requirements and procedures where they do not constitute a limitation within the meaning of Article 8.3 (Market Access) or Article 8.4 (National Treatment). These measures may include, in particular, the need to obtain a licence, to satisfy universal service obligations, to have recognised qualifications in regulated sectors, to have completed a recognised period of training, to pass specific examinations, including language examinations, to fulfil a membership requirement of a particular profession, such as membership in a professional organisation, to have a local agent for service, or to maintain a local address, or any non-discriminatory requirements that certain activities may not be carried out in protected zones or areas. While not listed, such measures continue to apply.

Definitions for Maritime Transport and Services Auxiliary to Maritime Transport for the Purposes of the Schedule of the United Kingdom

For the purposes of 11.A. of this Schedule, MARITIME TRANSPORT and SERVICES AUXILIARY TO MARITIME TRANSPORT:

“container station and depot services” means activities consisting of storing, stuffing, stripping, or repairing of containers and making containers available for shipment, whether in port areas or inland;

“maritime agency services” means the representation, within a given geographic area, as an agent of the business interests of one or more shipping lines or shipping companies, for the following purposes:

- (a) marketing and sales of maritime transport and related services, from quotation to invoicing, issuance of bills of lading on behalf of the shipping lines or shipping companies, acquisition and resale of the necessary related services, preparation of documentation, and provision of business information; and
- (b) acting on behalf of the shipping lines or shipping companies organising the call of the vessel or taking over cargo when required;

“maritime cargo handling services” means activities exercised by stevedore companies, including terminal operators but not including the direct activities of dockers if the workforce is organised independently of the stevedoring or terminal operator companies. The activities covered include the organisation, performance and supervision of:

- (a) the loading or discharging of cargo to or from a ship;
- (b) the lashing or unlashings of cargo; and
- (c) the reception or delivery and safekeeping of cargoes before shipment or after discharge;

“maritime freight forwarding services” means the organising and monitoring of shipments on behalf of shippers, through the supply of services including the arrangement of transport and related services, consolidation and packing of cargo, preparation of documentation, and provision of business information; and

“port services” means services provided inside a maritime port area or on the waterway access to that area by the managing body of a port, its subcontractors, or other service providers to support the transport of cargo or passengers. Port services include pilotage, towing and tug assistance, provisioning, fuelling and watering, garbage collecting and ballast waste disposal, port captain's services, navigation aids, emergency repair facilities, anchorage, berth, berthing and unberthing services and shore-based operational services essential to ship operations, including communications, water and electrical supplies.
